Lido Presidential Hurricane Preparedness Plan

When a hurricane is reported to be 48 to 72 hours away and headed in our direction a Hurricane Watch will be issued by the National Weather Service. There is a possibility of an evacuation within 48 hours.

Owners Responsibility

- Remove or have an arrangement to remove from your balcony all furniture, plants or any item that could reasonably be expected to be a hazard. If the build super must clear your balcony you will be charged \$30.00 per hour.
- To make sure the building superintendent knows your unit is occupied.
- Lock all doors and windows
- Recommend that water and power be shut off to water heater.
- Ensure building superintendent has all your current phone numbers

Building Superintendent Responsibility

- Move all pool furniture to a safe, secure location.
- Inform everyone in residence that a hurricane warning or an evacuation has been issued.
- If Mandatory Evacuation is ordered by the City of Sarasota turn off power to the elevators, water heater, and pool.
- If Mandatory Evacuation is ordered make sure everyone leaves. If they choose to stay inform them that no City emergency personnel will respond.
- Have a list with the status of everyone in residence and phone numbers so the board can keep them informed

After the Hurricane

- Building Superintendent will notify all in residence that the City of Sarasota has authorized re-entry to the island.
- Building Superintendent will inspect the building of any damages and take photos of the damages with a written report
- Building Superintendent will inform unit owners of any damages to their unit and assist them in making repairs.
